

**HEDGE END TOWN COUNCIL - MINUTES OF A FULL COUNCIL
MEETING HELD 16 NOVEMBER 2016**

6. Chair's Remarks

On behalf of the Chair, the Town Clerk advised members that Emma Norman has resigned both as a Town Councillor and that of a Borough Councillor and that the Notice of Vacancy has been issued. Cllr. Jane Welsh requested that the Town Council send good luck and best wishes to Emma Norman, which was unanimously agreed by members. The Chair reported that the Black History event for the commemoration of Mohammed Ali and the plaque dedication held on 29 October 2016 was very successful. He advised that he attended the Remembrance Day parade on 13 November 2016 and that 1,000 people attended and it was a privilege to lay a wreath on behalf of the community of Hedge End. Cllr. Helen Corben added that she attended a remembrance commemoration event at Cricket Camp on 12 November 2016 and had the honour of laying a wreath.

8. Borough and County Council Reports

Cllr. Margaret Allingham reported on the last HEWEB Local Area Committee meeting. She advised that authorisation was given for the diversion of a public footpath cycleway off Pavilion Road, Hedge End, to a new alternative footpath cycleway route as necessary, to facilitate the construction of development of a new nursing home. In addition, she advised that a planning application was received for a change of use of part of rear garden at West End to provide parking for Viking Kia and erection of a single storey extension to workshop building to provide an additional service bay and that the committee refused this application. Cllr. Margaret Allingham stated that the committee also considered parking revision arrangements at Shafford Meadows.

Cllr. Jerry Hall reiterated the refusal of the HEWEB LAC to allow Viking Kia to use a rear garden and stated that the business was too big in relation to the potential use of the plot. The committee also approved an increase in train station car park tariffs of 30p. He commented that the Remembrance Day parade was very dignified and that Mims Davies MP attended. Finally, he commented that the proposed parking restrictions consultation around various locations in Hedge End, ends on 18 November 2016.

Cllr. Bruce Tennent provided a Hampshire County Council report. He advised that Hampshire County Council intends to charge residents in care homes even if they have been admitted to hospital and this will take effect from December. He advised that in some cases residents

require a second carer albeit this can be questioned given that there are hoists available. However, from April 2017, Hampshire County Council will charge for second carers provision. Cllr. Bruce Tennent advised that in relation to charges that were brought in at waste recycling centres across Hampshire to save money, the courts have adjudged that the introduction of fee charging was not legal. Hampshire County Council is challenging the judgement and seeking clarification.

Cllr. Bruce Tennent advised that he recently attended the annual Southern Water stakeholders meeting and praised the utility for the provision of helpful information especially in relation to the works on the A27.

There being no further business to transact, the Chairman closed the meeting at 20.01 hours.
