H/22/92267, 41 Foord Road, Hedge End. Demolition of existing garage, two storey side extension with integral garage, new raised patio area and front porch. **RESOLVED: No Objection.** 

H/22/92240, 31 Allen Road, Hedge End. Erection of single-storey side and rear extensions. **RESOLVED: No Objection.** 

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H/22/92275, 67 Upper Northam Road, Hedge End. Addition of dormers to both sides of the roof. **RESOLVED: No Objection.** 

T/21/92113, Land near Hedge End Retail Park Roundabout. 1 no. Silver birch tree - Reduce away from the road by 4 metres. 1 no. Pine tree - Section fell to the ground level. RESOLVED: Trees are highly unlikely to be covered by the area TPO. The work is reasonable and compliant with the Highways Act 1980. We consider this area TPO needs reviewing as a matter of urgency to prevent other unauthorised tree works.

T/22/92261, 30 The Foxgloves, The Foxgloves, Hedge End. 1 no. oak (T1) - to reduce the lateral spread growing towards the roof and side of the flats by approximately 2.5 to 3m to suitable secondary growth points and to leave an approximate clearance of 1.5 to 2m from the building. 1 no. oak (T2) - to reduce the lateral spread away from the roof and rear of the flats by approximately 3m to suitable secondary growth points and leave a clearance from the building of approximately 2m. **RESOLVED:** No Objection to T2. T1 is not covered by a TPO and not required as part of the application, however we feel that this should be considered for a TPO.

T/22/92274, 7 Park View, Hedge End. G1: Mixed species (Conifer, Birch, Beech, Oak) - Light target prune of branches overhanging boundary up to a height of approx. 5m and back to the boundary line. **RESOLVED: No Objection subject to the usual conditions of the tree officer.**

- Cllr Paul Carnell noted that the development at Serenity (Hamble Wood) has illuminated signs on the hoarding boards.
