Terms and Conditions

The Competition will be open for entries from Monday 11th September until midnight Sunday 12th November 2023.

The image must be captured in Hedge End.

Photographs can be taken on cameras or mobile phones but they will need to be submitted digitally, a minimum of 2MB in size.

Photographs should be portrait – or be able to be cropped (without reducing the resolution too much) to fit on a portrait page for the Gazette front cover.

Entrants must have the relevant permissions for sharing the photo and agree to Hedge End Town Council using the image free of charge in its publications, website and on social media for an unlimited time.

Photographs should not contain identifiable adults or children.

The competition is open to all ages.

This is a competition for amateurs and photography enthusiasts. Entrants must not be professional photographers or receive payment for their photography work.

Entrants must live in Hedge End.

We will inform the winner by email or telephone and liaise with Trethowans regarding the gift voucher the winner would like to receive.

The entries will be judged by the Gazette Board, made up of six Councillors from Hedge End Town Council.

The Gazette Board's decision is final.

Please include your FIRST NAME and SURNAME and a TELEPHONE NUMBER, ADDRESS and a short DESCRIPTION of when and where the image was taken. *Other than names of winner/runners-up, this information will remain confidential and only be used for the purpose of running this competition.*

While there are no restrictions on when the photo was taken, please bear in mind that the winning entry will feature on the front cover of the Winter Gazette, so must feel appropriate for this time of year.
